The Adjective Clause Recognize an adjective clause when you see one. An adjective clause—also called an adjectival or relative clause—will meet three requirements: First, it will contain a subject and verb.; Next, it will begin with a relative pronoun [who, whom, whose, that, or which] or a relative adverb [when, where, or why].

Clauses: the Essential Building-Blocks

Adverbs can modify adjectives, but an adjective cannot modify an adverb. Thus we would say that "the students showed a really wonderful attitude" and that "the students showed a wonderfully casual attitude" and that "my professor is really tall, but not "He ran real fast.". Like adjectives, adverbs can have comparative and superlative forms to show degree.

What is an Adverb? An adverb is a word that is used to change, modify or qualify several types of words including an adjective, a verb, a clause, another adverb, or any other type of word or phrase, with the exception of determiners and adjectives, that directly modify nouns. A good way to understand adverbs is to think about them as the words that provide context.
