The underlying assumption derived from Gagné's ideas about learning and instruction: Because learning is complex and diverse, different learning outcomes (capabilities)... Events of learning operate on the learner in ways that constitute the conditions of learning.

But aside from the special conditions that will enhance each of these specific types of learning, there are also nine events of instruction which should be the starting point for every type of learning and every instructional design. These events were based on empirical observations of the instructional procedures and the information-processing model of learning and memory.

Nine instructional events and corresponding cognitive processes: The instructor then uses the conditions of learning for the particular learning outcome to determine the conditions necessary for learning. And finally, the events of instruction necessary to promote the internal process of learning are chosen and put into the lesson plan.
